## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021/2022-012** RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR STUDENT NEEDS FROM PRIVATE PURPOSE TRUST ACCOUNT TO GENERAL FUND ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, the Stanwood-Camano School District accepts donations intended for scholarships. student aid purposes, and other student needs and currently has an approximate balance of \$3,227.00 that have been accepted for these purposes and are currently held in an imprest account and on deposit with the County Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, these monies were previously reported as fiduciary funds and held in the Private Purpose Trust Fund, but no longer meet the criteria to be reported as fiduciary and therefore are more appropriately held in the General Fund.
